How to meet product mandatory EMC requirements?

This seminar will focus in depth on the most used international set of standards that are used to show conformance of information technology equipment to these mandatory EMC standards. These standards are CISPR Publication 22 (Emission limits and measurement methods) and CISPR 24 (Immunity limits and measurement methods). Use of these standards are worldwide and in fact the use of the European Norm version of these standards and meeting the limits therein gives the presumption of meeting the strict European Union regulatory essential requirements as stated in their EMC Directive. The FCC in this country has even been petitioned requesting that at least CISPR 22 be adopted as a replacement for their own Rules. The attendee will gain a better understanding of this activity, including changes that have been proposed in the past 6 months, to apply it to his/her product line and strategies for increasing and expediting market access internationally for those countries and regions of the world which adopt the work of the CISPR. Product managers, quality assurance personnel, testers, designers and standards staff involved with product conformity assessment to international markets of the latest measurement methods, proposed limits, and future conformity assessment activity will benefit from the knowledge gained by this special course.
